#### Arrival At School

Please remember that supervision of students begins at 8:20 a.m. Please insure that your child(ren) do not arrive at school earlier than 8:20 a.m. However, if there are circumstances where you may have to drop your child off early, they may wait on the benches inside the entrance until there is a teacher on

supervision. If you are aware of this in advance, please let your child's teacher know so arrangements can be made. The only exception to this is the School Safety Patrol students who need to be in place by 8:20 a.m.

#### Absence from School

If your child is going to be absent from school we would appreciate it if you would call the school after 8:00 a.m. to let us know. This is very important so that if a child goes astray between home and school we are aware of it and are able to take action as soon as possible.

As a reminder to our returning families, and information for our new families, we have recess at 12:00—12:20 and lunch afterwards. So the kids play first, then eat. They have a snack in the morning at around 10:30, so they aren't overly hungry at 12:00. Research asserts that kids feel better, eat more, and are more relaxed (promoting better digestion) if they eat after playing
